QuadReal has been informed today that there has been one confirmed case of Coronavirus (COVID-19) at Bower Place. The employee in question last worked on December 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021. We are following the direction of Public Health authorities and implementing our virus protocol.

## **Overview of action**

- A disinfection team was engaged to disinfect our common areas including washrooms corridors and all touch points.
- Alberta Health Services has both been notified, and we are working with them to ensure all employees and customers in the shopping Centre continue to be safe from any risk of transmission.

## **Minimizing risk to others**

The sick individuals are not currently working in the building and will not return until they are confirmed to be well. In the meantime, the building remains open and continues to operate as normal.

We encourage tenants to monitor the health of their employees carefully, recommending they stay at home and seek medical advice if they feel unwell. And of course, we continue to encourage everyone to reduce the risk of transmission by washing/sanitizing hands frequently and thoroughly, wearing face coverings, and taking other advisable precautionary measures.
